## What have been the major benefits to Wrexham?

*Over the last 12 months*

- Reduction in Vehicle Crime – **22%**
- Reduction in burglary dwelling – **39%**
- Reduction in Anti-Social Behaviour – **3%**
- Increased detection of drug related crime – **5%**
- Raised awareness about Domestic Abuse – **7%**

## What is the challenge for 2005-08?

- 17.5% reduction in overall crime
- Reduce Violent Crime
- Reduce the harm caused by drug and alcohol misuse
- Reduce Anti-Social Behaviour even more
- Raise awareness and tackle:
  - Hate Crime
  - Domestic Abuse
